The Constitution of India came into effect on 26th January 1950 and therefore, this day is celebrated as the Republic Day every year.

The Republic Day is celebrated throughout the country with great enthusiasm and vigour. A grand parade is held in New Delhi near the Rashtrapati Bhavan, along the Rajpath, past the India Gate and on to the historic Red Fort.

The President takes the salute of the marching contingents of the Army, Air Force, Navy, Paramilitary forces, Police and the National Cadet Corps.
