

## **ADMISSION AND REGISTRATION**

- ❖ School caters admission to classes-V to IX and XI for boys and girls with boarding facilities on basis of written Entrance test.
- ❖ The school is run primarily for children of serving army personnel at subsidized expenditure.
- ❖ Seats are offered to the children of War-Widows.
- ❖ All the other category are treated as civilians

## **Priorities for Admission**

The priorities for admission subject to availability of seats will be as under (As per Article 192 of AWES Rules and Regulations): -

- ❖ Children of serving Army personnel including DSC (Ex-Army), children of Army widows and children of those TA personnel who have a minimum of 5 years embodied service.
- ❖ Children of Ex-Army personnel retired/invalided out on medical grounds with pension, DSC personnel retired with pension from DSC.
- ❖ Children of serving Air Force, Naval and Coast Guard personnel.
- ❖ Children of retired Air Force, Naval and Coast Guard personnel.
- ❖ Children of Ex-Army personnel who left Army with less than 10 years of service and not categorized as ESM.
- ❖ Children of civilians paid out of Defence Estimates, Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF), MES, GREF, TA (when not embodied).
- ❖ Grand children of serving/retired Army Personnel.
- ❖ Other children.

## **ENTERANCE TEST**

- ❖ Child will only be registered on the receipt of registration fee.
- ❖ In addition, school also requires Birth Certificate.
- ❖ No child can appear in Entrance test unless he/she has been registered.
- ❖ The child can register from AWES website (<https://www.awesindia.com>)

## **CENTRE FOR ENTRANCE TEST (CLASS XI)**

- 1) Centre for Entrance test for class XI will be APS, Dagshai only. It will be conducted after board exam i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> week of April.
- 2) Admission to class XI (various streams) will be decided on the marks/grades scored by the students in the Half Yearly / Pre-Board as well as marks obtained in the Entrance test and vacancies available.
- 3) No child will be allowed to appear in the entrance test without submission of half yearly/ Pre board marks.
- 4) The criteria for admission to various streams in class XI will be as per CBSE/AWES rules.
- 5) The Entrance test will consist of one paper with different sections in single sitting for the following subjects:

### **PLEASE NOTE:**

- ❖ No admission is offered in Class X and Class XII.
- ❖ Admission to school is subject to the result of an Entrance Test and Vacancies Available. However, the school management has the right to reject admission at any stage if processing due to any discrepancy in documents or in case of a child being medically unfit.
- ❖ Admission to Class XI will be decided on the marks/grades scored by the student in Half yearly/Pre boards as well as marks obtained in the Entrance test and vacancies available.

## **DOCUMENTS REQUIRE AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION**

- 1) Transfer Certificate in original.
  - i) Scanned copy of the TC issued by CBSE affiliated school shall be uploaded on their official school website.
  - ii) Transfer Certificate issued by non-CBSE schools shall be countersigned by the District Education officer/appropriate Education authorities.
- 2) Progress report of previous class passed along with character certificate (in original)
- 3) Photocopy of AADHAR CARD of student.
- 4) Passport size photographs (8 nos.).
- 5) Medical history form (duly filled and signed by competent medical authority) with blood group of the child.
- 6) Indemnity bond on stamp paper / e-stamp of Rs.10/-
- 7) Anti-ragging affidavit on Stamp paper of Rs.20/-
- 8) For serving/retired defence personnel only (which ever applicable):
  - i) Medical cover: Dependents of defence personnel.
  - ii) Defence Personnel Service Certificate.
  - iii) Medical Dependent Card / ECHS Card of Dependent of ESM.
  - iv) Photocopy of Pension Pay Order (PPO) and Discharge Book.
- 9) Certificate of Category in case of SC, ST AND OBC.
- 10) Part 2 order for Army personnel
- 11) Serving certificate (Army personnel).

## **TRANSFER CERTIFICATE**

The school will accept the child for admission if he/she does not appear for the annual exam of class he/she is studying in and has been offered a place by the school, but the transfer certificate should say that the child is currently studying in a particular class, giving the date of birth and also stating that all dues have been cleared.

## **MODE AND SCHEDULE OF PAYMENTS OF FEE AND BILLS**

- ❖ Fee is charged from month of admission or as specified in transfer certificate.
- ❖ The entire fee amount as per details given in the fee structure is required to be deposited at beginning of session.
- ❖ No cash will be accepted in the school office.
- ❖ Every year fee will be paid in lump sum by 31<sup>st</sup> march by the parents even if the bill/circular is not received by them.

**THE FOLLOWING PENALTIES ARE LEVIED FOR LATE PAYMENT: -**

- ❖ If the fee as mentioned on the previous page is not deposited by due date i.e. 31<sup>st</sup> march, late fee will be charged as per para 282 of AWES rules.
- ❖ Please note that if the fee together with the penalty is not paid within stipulated time i.e. 30 June the school management reserves the right to take appropriate action of striking off the student from rolls in accordance with para 283 of AWES rules.
- ❖ The penalty for late payment of fee cannot be waived off under any circumstances.
- ❖ The school does not hold itself responsible for any postal delay regarding sending reminders for fee/other bills. Therefore, parents are requested to make all payments in time to avoid penalties.
- ❖ In case, of any doubt regarding the payment of dues, parents are advised to make payments and then ask for refund instead of waiting for the decision on dues. This will avoid fines/penalties being levied for late payment and other consequences.
